Notification period

All students will receive a decision regarding their application before 1 June at the latest. Applying earlier does not mean that you will receive our decision earlier.

Please note that timely handling cannot be guaranteed in case of incomplete applications.

Are you an UvA Bachelor's student with a Bachelor's degree in "Sociale Geografie", "Planologie" or "Sociologie" and applying to the corresponding Master's programme (doorstroommaster)

Are you an UvA Bachelor's student in "Sociale Geografie", "Planologie" or "Sociologie" and do you graduate before 1 September? Then you do not need to submit an application via MyInfo when you are applying to the corresponding Master's programme. Your enrollment will become definitive as soon as the UvA has registered your graduation. Your graduation date must be no later than 31 August in order to be able to start the Master's programme on 1 September.

Expected selectivity

All students must meet specific entry requirements. The entry requirements are listed on our website. Please refer to the information on application and admission per programme. In case of additional entry requirements in combination with a limited capacity, the selection of the best candidates will be based on all aspects of their application file after the check on the entry requirements.
