ADDENDUM TO THE PROFILING FUND REGULATIONS.

A "Student Council Allowance" of \notin 420 per administrative month granted under the *Profileringsfonds* regulation will be added to the regulation.

The "Student Council Allowance" covers students with the following positions: DB member CSR; Member-CSR / council assistant; Delegate; DB FSR; Member-FSR / council assistant

The change is retroactive to September 1, 2023. The time of payment refers to the reference date. The increase "Student Council Allowance" is set for college years 2023/2024 and 2024/2025 pending the overall review of the profiling fund.
